Minimum Spend & Delivery Details

- A minimum flower value of £700 may apply if your venue is more than 30 miles from my Cumbernauld studio.
- Delivery is available for orders over £250. Orders below this amount are welcome to be collected directly from the studio.
- Standard delivery charges apply, based on location and logistics.

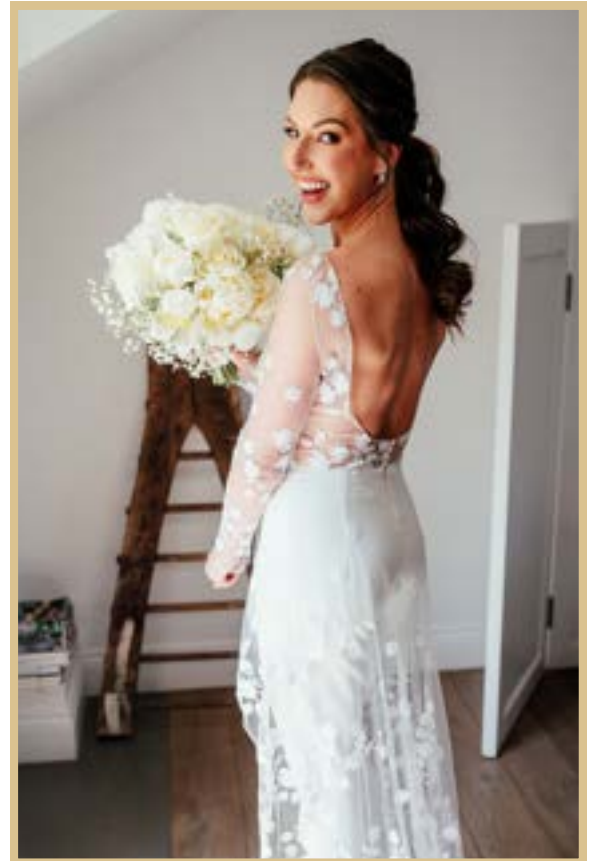
Eloppements and Mirco Weddings

• Small in size, big on beauty

• First things first—there are no rules saying elopements and micro weddings can't be a flower-filled extravaganza! That said, many couples choosing to elope opt for just a bridal bouquet and a few buttonholes to keep things simple and elegant.

• For a bridal bouquet and single buttonhole, you can expect to spend somewhere between £110 and £185, depending on style, flower choices, and season.
